OTHER

For those of you flying, the nearest major airport is Portland about a 2 hr. drive to Lincoln City. **Proposal:** If there is enough interest, a motor coach will be arranged for transport from / return to Portland at a rate more affordable than a 5 day car rental at about the \$40 range. With travel arrival on Sunday 5/6, arrangements would be negotiated for lodging at an airport hotel with a Monday a.m. bus departure to *Chinook Winds*. Return would depart mid- a.m. Friday to the same airport hotel making mid-afternoon return flight departures possible. If you are interested in accepting this proposal, get back with me post haste and if there is enough interest, I will set into motion the above plan. In the event of high interest, your seat reservation will be on a first come, first served basis. [If there is really a lot of interest, a second motor coach is possible.]

Once the program is fleshed out, a final menu for the reception and banquet is decided and travel arrangements made, you will be advised regarding a registration fee and registration process but expect it to be about a \$100 inclusive fee.
